This award celebrates Australia or New Zealand's most innovative and influential stylists in Editorial and Runway hair design. The winner will demonstrate exceptional creativity, technical skill, and a deep understanding of seasonal trends, while showcasing their ability to translate high-fashion concepts into editorial and runway contexts.

This category is open to qualified hairdressers across every business setting - salon-employed, salon owners, chair-renters, suite operators, freelance, and independent operators alike.

Each entrant is only permitted to submit one entry in this category. Entrants in this category may also enter other categories, provided all entries meet the relevant Category Rules & Criteria.

Entry Requirements

Entrants must submit a portfolio that includes work from four (4) distinct projects/jobs, which were created during the awards period. Entries should reflect the entrant's most impactful and representative work during this period:

- Each distinct project/job represented must include two (2) images (with a total of 8 images per entry).
- Eligible work includes, but is not limited to: Editorial campaigns (magazine spreads, digital features, etc.)
- Runway shows (e.g., Fashion Weeks in Australia, New Zealand, or internationally)
- Celebrity shoots
- Advertising campaigns
- Collaborations with fashion designers, photographers, or makeup artists

Judging

Criteria

- Creativity and Innovation: Unique and forward-thinking hair designs that push boundaries.
- Technical Skill: Precision and expertise in execution



- Trend Influence: Evidence of shaping or interpreting global hair and fashion trends
- Collaboration: Demonstrated ability to work seamlessly with photographers, designers, and other creatives
- Versatility: Ability to excel across a variety of Session Styling contexts

Submission Checklist

This checklist is EVERYTHING that is required from you in order to successfully submit your completed entry on the online AHFA Awards Platform:

1. 8 x JPEG Images in High Res (max file size 20MB per image)

Please upload these in the order of 1-8, naming them like the following example without your name in the file names:

- HighRes_1
- HighRes_2

2. The same 8 x JPEG Images in Low Res (max file size 5MB per image)

Please upload these in the order of 1-8, naming them like the following example without your name in the file names:
LowRes1_ LowRes2_

3. Printed Mounted Collection

In addition to your digital submission, you must send a printed and mounted A4 copy of each photograph in your entered collection. The printed mounted collection is what the Australian judging panel will view in person at the Live Gallery Judging Day:

Print: professional quality, A4 size, one print per photograph in your entered collection.

Mount: each A4 print must be mounted - we recommend Core Flute (lightweight, sturdy, and ideal for gallery display).

Deadline: the printed mounted collection must be received by the same date as your entry closing date. Send to:

4. WRITTEN SUBMISSION PDF

(This is a written answer with a max file size of 20MB uploaded to the AHFA Awards Platform as ONE PDF in total for all the below questions).

Each project/job submitted must detail the following:

- Name of person/organisation issuing the brief
- Succinct outline of the brief provided
- A short description of how the entrant has interpreted the brief

5. Press Kit as a PDF Document

(up to 5 pages - max file size 10MB) which includes: (Please note Press Kits are not for judging purposes)

- 1 x Cover/Bio Page detailing the entrant's full name, salon name, category being entered, email address, contact number and social media handles + project/job credits

- Any career highlights, experiences, and accolades, including achievement dates

6. 1 x High Res PR / Headshot of Entrant

7. Collection credits

(a text box in the Awards Platform has been labelled for you to copy and paste your answer directly into your entry).
Collection credits should include (Please repeat the below details for all 4 projects/jobs entered):

- Your Name
- Project/Job Name
- Stylist/Colourist (if required)
- Photographer
- Makeup Artist
- Fashion Stylist

8. Statutory Declaration (Stat Dec)

This is an online form you will complete on the Awards Platform to confirm (no printing required):

- All work is original, accurate, and meets category criteria
- Permissions from models, photographers, and contributors are secured where relevant

Rules

1) Awards Period

The 2027 Australian Hair Fashion Awards (AHFA) Awards Periods are:

Premium, Creative, and Business Categories: 10 November 2025 - 18 January 2027

Product Categories: 18 September 2025 - 2 November 2026.

All images and/or video, and/or content submitted/referenced in your entry MUST have been created during the above applicable Awards Period.

2) Residency And Practice Requirement

Editorial/Runway Stylist Category Entrants' primary place of residence/base must be in Australia or New Zealand for at least 80% of the Awards Period. We understand travel may be required to fulfill international jobs and projects.

The Australian Hair Fashion Awards (AHFA) is honoured to welcome New Zealand Hairdressers to compete within the awards program. All categories, excluding Eastern Australian Hairdresser of the Year, Western/Central Australian Hairdresser of the Year, Australian Hairdresser of the Year, and Global Hairdresser of the Year, are open to New Zealand based hairdressers. There is a category created specifically for New Zealand based hairdressers to enter: New Zealand Hairdresser of the Year.

If you are unsure about whether you meet the criteria above - please enquire with the AHFA Awards team.

3) Image Specifications

DIGITAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Your collection must be submitted in A4 Portrait Format Only and provided in two digital image formats:

8 x High Res jpeg image (up to 20MB per image) 8 x Low Res jpeg image (up to 5MB per image)

All images must be named using the following format: Highres_number e.g. highres_1 Lowres_number e.g. lowres_1

All digital images must be submitted through our Awards Platform, available via www.australianhairfashionawards.com

PRINTING AND MOUNTING SPECIFICATIONS:

In addition to your digital submission, you must send a printed and mounted A4 copy of each photograph in your entered collection. The printed mounted collection is what the Australian judging panel will view in person at the Live Gallery Judging Day:

Print: professional quality, A4 size, one print per photograph in your entered collection.

Mount: each A4 print must be mounted - we recommend Core Flute (lightweight, sturdy, and ideal for gallery display).

4) Statutory Declaration

You will find this section as a simple online form pre-loaded on the Awards Platform (no printing required). As you go through the process of completing your entry, you will be directed to sign and submit it online. You will be confirming that all work, details, and materials submitted as part of your entry are your original work and are true and accurate, and meet the specific criteria for the category/s you are entering. It also includes your confirmation that you have the appropriate permissions from models, photographers and any other suppliers that have contributed to your entry.

Please note that your entry is not valid until this online form has been completed.

5) Hair Enhancement

Wigs, wefts, hairpieces, and hair extensions are permitted for use, however, please note that the judging criterion is heavily based on realistic presentation including believable formation and movement of the hair.

6) Collab Collection by Colourist and Stylist

A hairdresser may enter a collection where he/she has completed the cutting and styling, and another hairdresser has completed the colour work, however the colourist's name must be included within the credits (with the entrant only being the Cutter/Stylist). The colourist may enter the same collection into the AHFA Creative Colourist of the Year category, where styling credits are attributed to the other hairdresser (with the entrant only being the Colourist).

7) Judging Panel - Live Gallery in Sydney

This category will now be judged at the AHFA Live Gallery Judging Day in Sydney, by an Australian panel of the country's most respected hairdressers, each highly qualified with a strong understanding of the local creative market. Entrants send in printed and mounted collections, which are placed in a gallery for the panel to view in person, side by side, in real time. Judges score independently on this dedicated judging day, and all scores are entered through Award Force, a globally recognised, third-party awards software platform used by competitions across many industries internationally. No-one can override a judge's score once it has been entered in the platform, and the entrants in the live gallery photographic collection judging remain anonymous during the judging process.

9) Releasing Your Collection for Publication

Whilst we understand some or all of your collection may have been released prior to entry, we ask that you do not publicise what you are specifically entering as your AHFA Collection until after the Finalist Announcement has been made.

A representation of all finalist collections will be published on once finalists are announced. Non-finalists' collections may also be published across MDivision digital platforms after the finalist announcement. www.thejournalmag.com

10) Requirements for Finalists and Winners

Across all internal and external communications, publicity, marketing, and PR, AHFA finalists and winners must include the year of their award alongside their title.

E.g. Winners Name - 2027 AHFA Editorial / Runway Stylist of the Year.

This rule is set to respect all winners and finalists.

11) Copy Of Your Work

Please note that all collections and information submitted become property of The Australian Hair Fashion Awards / MDivision Pty Ltd. Entrants are advised to keep personal copies of their entries.

12) Entry Fees

Entry into the Editorial and Runway Stylist of the Year Category is \$AUD175 (ex GST) per entry, which is payable upon successfully submitting your entry on the AHFA Awards Platform.

13) Entry Deadline

Please refer to www.australianhairfashionawards.com for the entry deadlines.

In rare cases, a deadline extension may be considered - please apply by emailing ahfa@mdivision.com.au with your reason for extension clearly stipulated in your email. Please note that extensions can be difficult to grant due to judging timelines already being confirmed with our busy Judging Panel. If an extension is possible, it is unlikely to be more than a few days extra.

The AHFA have the right to make adjustments to the above Rules and Criteria if they deem it to be in the best interest of entrants and the integrity that these Awards stand for. We will make all reasonable attempts to inform you of these changes.
